## Communiqué from Al-Islambouli Brigades

[Note: The use of the name “Al-Islambouli” is a likely reference to Lt. Khaled al-Islambouli, the leader of a group of Islamic extremists who brazenly assassinated Egyptian President Anwar Sadat in Cairo in 1981. Khaled’s brother—Mohammed Shawqi al-Islambouli—is a wanted terrorist fugitive and ranking leader of the Egyptian Al-Gama’at al-Islamiyya. Mohammed al-Islambouli is also suspected to be linked to Al-Qaida, and probably hiding in Pakistan, Afghanistan, or Iran. It is impossible at this time to determine the authenticity of this statement, or its precise connection to the al-Islambouli brothers.]

**“In the Name of Allah Most Gracious Most Merciful:”**

**“...one of our blessed brigades carried out an attempt to collect the head of one of America’s infidels in Pakistan while he was returning from Fateh Jang, but Allah, Glory be to Him, wanted him to live on... With this attack, we direct a message to the Pakistani government and its leader the hypocrite traitor Pervez Musharraf, who continues to deliver the captured fighters to America, to its satisfaction... This operation that took place yesterday will be followed by a series of painful attacks if you do not cease what you are doing by surrendering to the evil commands of Bush, and we are giving you a chance to stop that. Or else, the mujahideen will strike again on Pakistani territory, and we will make it a bloody war on your head, and on the heads of all the evil politicians who follow you. This is the final warning we will send to you, or else there will be another response, within the coming few days, our brigades will speak in the language of blood which is the only language you understand.”**
