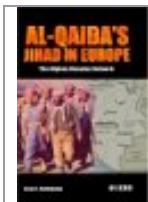

“All praise be to Allah, Lord of the Worlds... Allah said, ‘Fight them until there is no more dissent and the religion of Allah is supreme so that there will be no aggression except that done on the oppressors.’”

“In this era, the athiests and hypocrites rule over the Muslim countries, while the Jewish media disseminates hypocrisy and athiesm. The Brigade of Martyr Fawwaz al-Otaibi has carried out an attack on the military camp of the 15th Brigade. As a result of the assault operation, two soldiers from the Kuwaiti army were killed. After entering the military camp, the brothers discovered the presence of several American soldiers. They immediately killed all three of them. When the idolatrous soldiers learned what had befallen their American brothers, they sought refuge and deserted the camp. The mujahideen were able to seize a Korean soldier, who was killed and tortured in the camp square. The mujahideen entered the mosque of the camp and praised Allah in supplication. Afterwards, the mujahideen learned from a sympathetic soldier that special forces were en route to the camp—and with that, all of the mujahideen departed. Some were headed for the Umm Al-Haiman district while the others went in another direction. Because the idolatrous soldiers had learned of the escape of the mujahideen from the camp, they encircled Umm al-Haiman and sealed all its entrances and exits. The battle ensued between the soldiers of Allah and the soldiers of the idol. Though the mujahideen numbered only three, they were able to kill four of the idolatrous soldiers. Meanwhile, one of the brothers was martyred: the martyr Abu al-Baraa al-Kandahari, may Allah have mercy on him, whom we pray for. One of the brothers was also arrested, while brother Abu Mohammed al-Kuwaiti was able to break through their cordon in order to make his escape and flee the area.”

“This is proof from the mujahideen of Kuwait that we are marching on the path and continuing in the jihad. We will not forget the blood of our brothers, and we swear that we are watching you, O’ soldiers of the idol. We will not be undermined by fatwahs [Islamic edicts] about jihad from the representatives of the rulers. Allahu Akhbar, and the honor goes to Allah, his prophet, and the believers.”
