Communiqué from the Mujahideen Army of Iraq

“Communiqué from the ‘Mujahideen Army’ regarding the harmful blasphemy against the blessed Prophet Mohammed.”

“...We, along with the rest of the world, have observed the offensive and harmful blasphemy against the blessed messenger Mohammed. This wrongdoing was perpetrated by several institutions from the promiscuous countries Denmark and Norway who secretly hate Islam and its leaders. We thought that out of politeness and consideration for their own interests, these countries would apologize or reprimand those responsible for this wrongdoing. However, their hatred, resentment, and animosity towards our religion kept them from reacting. By doing so, the officials in those countries have revealed their true colors, and now Muslims from all over the world know the truth about those we have given our money to, who we have bought merchandise from, whose lifestyle we imitated, and whose countries we visited in order to get a taste of the marginal things in this world that have become their utmost concern and constitute all that they know.”



“This harmful blasphemy that they have boldly and openly perpetrated—and that their leaders and dignitaries have insisted on being within the boundaries of freedom of speech, and freedom of thought—constitutes an ominous sign and a miserable position as well. It stems from secret animosity, eternal hatred, and a clear insistence on being hostile toward Islam, the blessed Prophet Mohammed, and the holy Quran. These events make it imperative for every proud Muslim to realize that the hateful Zionist-inflicted crusaders are constantly at war with the Islamic religion, its people, and its leaders as well—until the day in which Allah will inherit the land and its inhabitants...”

“Anyone who is in his right mind and is passionate about his religion and his beloved and blessed Prophet should act in defense of and to avenge the blessed Prophet selected by Allah. Wherever we see traces or hear echoes of these people, we must show them who blessed Mohammed is, and who his followers are as well. Settling for [merely] boycotting these cowards is a position of weakness that is indicative of a feeble nation that does not stand up in defense of its Prophet and the principles that it believes in. They started [the battle] and they should suffer its consequences.”

“We call upon all our brigades in the Mujahideen Army to attack whatever they possibly can in these two countries specifically, and in other countries who repeat what they have done... Let us make our own efforts on top of Allah’s expected revenge—and hopefully, Allah will choose us to be among those who seek revenge for Mohammed in his name, as this in itself is a great honor for a Muslim.”
