“In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful:”

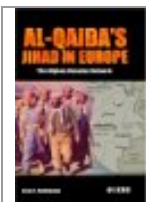
“All praise be to almighty Allah and prayers to his messenger Mohammed, his family, and supporters.”
