

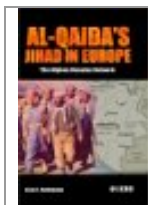

can they possibly be exempt from fulfilling their obligation when the reasons for jihad are still relevant, and have recently been reconfirmed with the launch of the crusader campaign against Muslim lands? Fourthly, the brothers who have been released must not immerse themselves in worldly pleasures, or forget about their religion. This could bring them to trust the oppressive tyrants, just as Allah has warned us... They must always remember that their release is Allah's salvation on the one hand, and a test on the other. Allah uses this test to separate the righteous from the liars, and distinguish between those who are firm in their belief and those who are not.
