



Communiqué from "Al-Qaida's Jihad Committee in Mesopotamia" (Abu Musab al-Zarqawi)



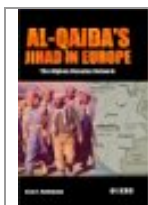

"A statement from Al-Qaida's Committee in Mesopotamia denying the alleged arrest of an aide to al-Zarqawi."

"In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful:"

"All praise be to almighty Allah and prayers to his messenger Mohammed, his family, and supporters... The media has published reports that the enemies of Allah have arrested an aide to al-Zarqawi. We are already familiar with the lies spread by the crusader media, which is dictated by the crusaders and the leaders of the Jews. We, Al-Qaida's Committee in Mesopotamia, deny that the alleged arrest took place. The increasing numbers of these rumors serves no purpose other than to try and hide their defeat from their people (the enemies of Allah). All praise be to Allah for his blessings, the strikes of our mujahideen are increasing and more and more people are approaching Al-Qaida day after day, asking for jihad and defending the religion of almighty Allah. Your brothers from Al-Qaida's Committee in Mesopotamia will continue their jihad and fight against the enemies of Allah until the laws of Allah will rule over this country and its people."
