

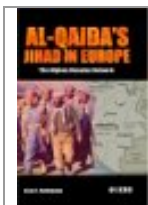

“The martyr rushed to Iraq and was part of the vanguard of those who rushed to the country when the battles in Al-Qaim were at their most intense, amidst the sounds of shrieking bullets and warplanes. “The martyr appeared in one of the brothers’ dreams after his death. He was swimming in pristine rivers, his hair had lengthened, and he had a smile across his face. A great number of people accompanied him in the final moments before he was buried. I indeed hope that he will join the ranks of the martyrs and live beside blessed Allah in paradise. Do not be sad, O’ mother of Raed [al-Banna]—for with the help of Allah, your son has become a martyr and he shall serve as your interlocutor on the day [of judgment] when neither property nor children will matter. You have the privilege of celebrating, reveling, and handing out candy when you hear about his death! O’ Raed—blessings to you on your martyrdom, and we hope to see you again soon in paradise, with the help of Allah.”
