



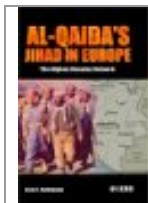

I can tell you that Abu Suhaib participated in the battle of Fallujah—where America was humiliated—and was able to kill nine Americans during several battles in just one day. After the battle, Abu Suhaib met with other brothers under a tree where he prayed and wept. Then, they went to the river in order to pass across to the other side. Although Abu Suhaib had a vision during which he was killed in a river, he did not hesitate and took the lead among his brothers. He refused to let go of his weapon while swimming because he thought perhaps he would encounter and kill more Americans on the other side of the river. But, he did not survive and was drowned in the river... May Allah have mercy on your soul, O’ Abu Suhaib. I shall also not forget Abu Abdelrahman and Abu Muslim al-Shami, of whom I do not know whether they achieved martyrdom or are still alive and soon will return to us. I ask you to keep the promise, safeguard the jihād, defend the possessions of the Muslims, and journey to fight in the land of jihād.”
