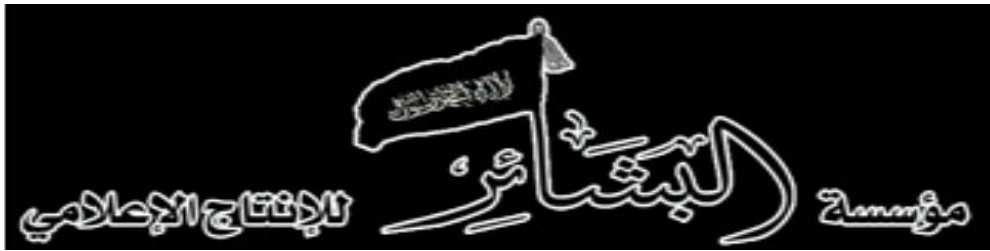

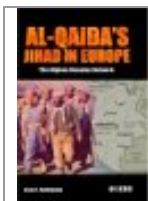
"The Al-Bashaer Committee: A statement regarding the martyrdom of our heroic mujahideen."

"...The Saudi Arabian government has killed our courageous brothers (may Allah accept them as martyrs) as part of its war against Islam under the banner of the so-called war on terrorism. It is clear to every Muslim that this apostate government has made strong efforts aimed at stopping the jihad in an effort to draw nearer to the Christian Bush... We ask Allah to accept our martyr brothers: Mohammed bin Rashid al-Jalidan, who went to Iraq to defend Islam but was arrested in Syria and delivered to the oppressors in the Arabian Peninsula; Sami bin Saud al-Mutairi, who went to Iraq and met with Abu Musab Al-Zarqawi and then returned to Saudi Arabia to meet Shaykh Abdullah al-Rashoud when he was arrested; later, [al-Mutairi] was released, arrested again, and finally was able to escape. Also, we ask Allah to grant his mercy on brothers Mushil bin Abdullah al-Rashoud, Hammoud bin Muqbil al-Otaibi, Said bin Abdullah al-Muayzar, and Ghazi bin Salim al-Otaibi."



"...Finally, we inform the Saudi government and anyone else who aids it in its war against Islam that the future will bring even more fierce responses than before. We will soon publish a letter by Shaykh Abu Abdullah al-Qahtani titled 'Advice and Sympathies to the Camps of the Infidels and Hypocrites.'"
