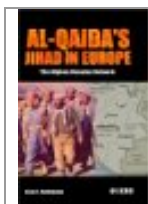
"A statement from Al-Qaida's Committee in Mesopotamia regarding the Al-Ansar attack in Amman."

"In the name of Allah, Most Gracious, Most Merciful:"

"All praise be to almighty Allah and prayers to his messenger Mohammed, his family, and his supporters... During these times of exile, a group of martyrdom seekers [have entered] paradise—heroes from the Al-Baraa bin Malik [Martyrs] Brigade... after approximately a month of gathering intelligence on the targets (which were targeted for the reasons explained in our previous statement), the group assumed the duty of planning and preparing for the mission. The group consisted of commander Abu Khabib, Abu Muaz, Abu Omaira and sister Umm Omaira who chose to follow her husband on his journey to achieve martyrdom. All of them were Iraqis from the land of Mesopotamia... who decided the follow the shortest path to achieve the blessing of Allah... The executors [of the mission] entered the targets before the blasts occurred. Keeping their faith in Allah, they were successful in passing through all of the security arrangements that the traitor King Abdullah keeps boasting about. It was agreed to use explosive belts in order to precisely strike the targets. At the moment of execution, the commander Abu Khabib detonated himself at the Radisson, followed by Abu Muaz at the Hyatt, and Abu Omair and his wife [Umm Umaira] detonated themselves inside the Days Inn..."

"Let the Jews realize that their wall that was built to the east of the Jordan river... is now a target for the lions of al-Tawheed and soon they [the Jews] will be reached by the mujahideen... Allahu Akhbar, Allahu Akhbar, and the honor goes to Allah, his prophet, and the mujahideen."
