Communiqué #18 from Al-Qaida's Committee in the Arabian Peninsula

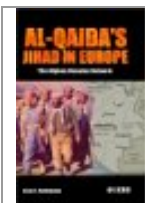


September 10, 2004

“On Friday night, 18 Rajab 1425, one of the mujahideen brigades received news that the idolatrous soldiers were about to raid their house... in the west of Brida [north of Riyadh]. They quickly evacuated the house, bringing the families out first, and then following up with the departure of the remaining mujahideen. When the car with the families in it tried to leave quickly, two of the tyrant’s soldiers in a security patrol opened heavy fire on it, attempting to stop it and indifferent to the presence of women inside. The mujahideen responded by firing upon them, and killing two of them. The Interior Ministry announced the death of one of them immediately, and the death of the other later.”

“While this happened, numerous police cars and security patrols began firing on the car from behind, but another group of the mujahideen—thanks to Allah—clashed with them, and blockaded their path until the car with the families was able to withdraw and escape from the siege. The results left five police officers wounded, and they returned from the raid... a complete failure. And the confrontations have also resulted in the martyrdom of one of the mujahideen—we consider him as such and Allah as his guide—he is Abdel Latif Bin Hamad Al-Khodairi, Allah have mercy upon him and accept him among the martyrs.”
